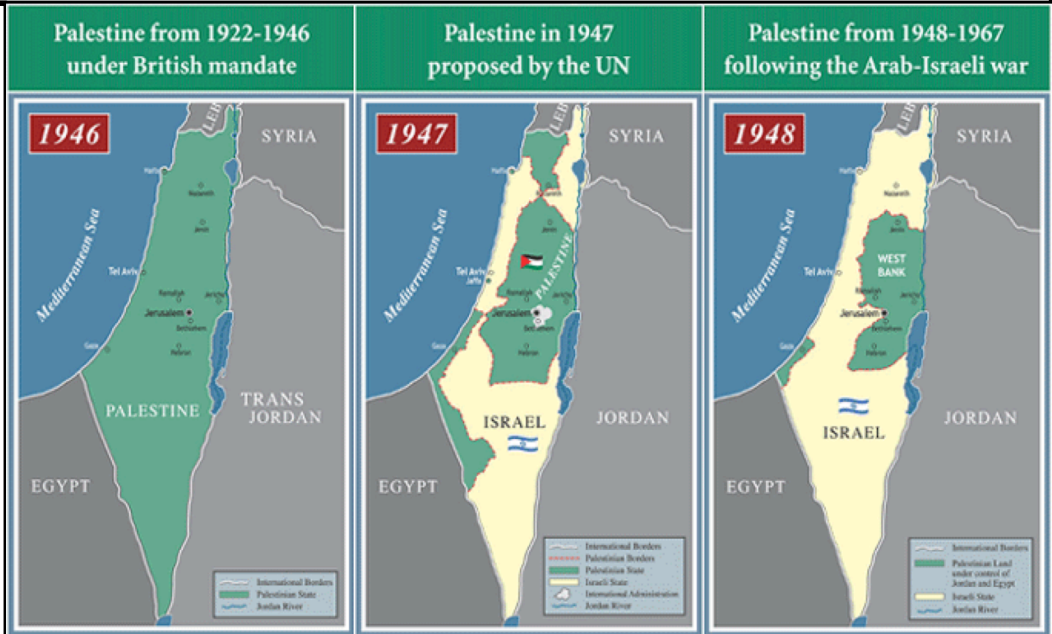
Palestine Today = Israel, The Gaza Strip, and the West Bank.
